

EXERCISE 1: TYPE ANATOMY

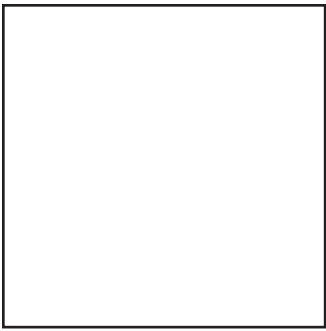
