

# EXERCISE 6: PROJECT PLAN

**DUE DATE:** Monday, April 6 at the start of class

This exercise coincides with Project 6 directly. For Project 6, you need to come up with a project plan as a group. After deciding what type of project you want to create, you should do some research. Your research needs to, at minimum, satisfy the following items:

- Look for examples of the chosen type of project
- Research the materials you believe you will need to complete the project
- Research any process or techniques you may not know about that you will need to complete your project
- Locations for project if doing something involving an installation

Using this research, you should begin developing a project plan. Start with sketching out what you think the project will be. Begin coming up with measurements. Begin figuring out a supply list and who will procure what. Determine what facilities and equipment you might need access to on campus. You should submit a formal plan stating what the project is, sketches explaining the final format, a plan for who does what, and list of what supplies/equipment you will need. You should also include a summary of the research done for the project.
